The Alliance to Preserve the Civil War Defenses of Washington was founded in 2008 to help preserve these sites and expand public knowledge and appreciation of them. We also assist the National Park Service in annually commemorating the **Battle of Fort Stevens, July 11-12, 1864**, the only Civil War battle in the nation's capital and the only time a sitting President (Lincoln) has come under direct enemy fire. **The 154th anniversary commemoration will be held at Fort Stevens on Saturday July 14, 2018.** It will feature military and civilian reenactors, speeches and informal talks by historians and other Civil War experts, hourly musket firings, period music, programs for children and other activities.

The Alliance's work is funded in part by grants from the Humanities Council of Washington DC and Walmart Foundation. Many individuals also provide financial and volunteer support.
